Ascension Debris Pickup to Begin Wednesday

Ascension Parish President Clint Cointment announced today that the first pass for debris removal will begin Wednesday, June 16.

Parish government has contracted with DRC Emergency services of Metairie to remove construction and demolition debris, and Thompson Consulting of Maitland Florida will handle debris monitoring.

Residents who need flood debris removed must first contact the Citizens Service Center at 225-450-1200 or be previously registered at www.damage.la.gov.

Residents are reminded to place debris in the road and street rights-of-way for pick up. Debris crews cannot go onto private property to retrieve debris. This applies only to construction debris, such as building materials, carpet, drywall, furniture, lumber, mattresses, and plumbing.

Appliances and white goods, such as freezers, refrigerators, washer and dryers, will not be picked up; owners must dispose of that individually. Residents can dispose of their white goods by dropping them off at the Ascension Parish Recycling Center, 42077 Churchpoint Road, Gonzales. Operating hours are Monday through Thursday from 7 am until 4 pm, and Saturday from 9 am until 1 pm.
