Last Call for Vegetation Debris Drop-Off Following Hurricane Francine (Roadside Debris Pickup Will Continue)

Ascension Parish, LA - Ascension Parish Government is announcing the end of vegetative debris drop-off services for residents impacted by Hurricane Francine at the Ashland Road entrance to Lamar-Dixon in Gonzales and the LaLa Regira Baseball Complex, 725 Church Street, in Donaldsonville. The final date for debris drop-off is **September 30, 2024, at 5:00 p.m.** Residents are urged to take advantage of these services before they conclude.

Roadside debris pickup services will continue for residents as part of ongoing recovery efforts following the impact of Hurricane Francine. Residents must separate vegetative debris from construction/demolition debris. If debris is not separated, it will not be picked up. If bags are used, they must be clear.
