## Ascension Parish Government Announces Final Day for Hurricane Francine Debris Registration

**Gonzales, LA** - Ascension Parish Government is reminding residents that **Wednesday, October 23, 2024**, is the last day to register for debris pick-up following Hurricane Francine. This deadline marks the end of a month-long effort to clear storm-related debris from public rights-of-way across the parish.

Residents who have yet to register their debris are urged to do so by the deadline to ensure their materials are collected. To date, **more than 13,000 cubic yards of debris have already been removed** from the community, contributing to the continued recovery of our parish.

"This effort has been a crucial part of our recovery process, and we appreciate the cooperation of our residents," said Parish President Clint Cointment. "Please make sure any remaining debris is separated and placed at the right of way and that you've registered for pick-up before the deadline so we can complete our work efficiently."
