Community Needs Survey Snapshot

Who took the survey?



- 80% West Bank residents
- 68% Donaldsonville residents
- Balanced age range, slightly more 50+ than under 50
- 52% White, 44% Black/African American
- Nearly equal gender split

Quality of Life

Average rating: 2.6 out of 5



Top priorities:

- Responsive government services (88% rated "Very Important")
- Well-paying jobs (78%)
- Housing variety (79%)
- Parks & recreation, retail/dining, environmental protection

Housing Preferences

Most desired housing types across all ages:



- Large lot single-family homes (56%)
- Small lot single-family homes (52%)
- Townhouses (36%)
- Mid-rise apartments (33%)
- Under 50 slightly favored mid-density options such as townhouses and mid-rise apartments
- Over 50 showed more interest in agerestricted and accessory dwelling units.

- Small business development (83%)
- Health & family services (53%)
- Parks & recreation (54%)
- Affordable housing (48%)
- Alternative transportation options (33%)

Infrastructure Priorities



- Drainage/stormwater (67%)
- Road safety & repairs (64%)
- Sidewalks/bike lanes (54%)
- Water quality & reliability (54%)
- Wastewater treatment (32%)

- Skilled trades (81%)
- Professional services (66%)
- Industrial/manufacturing (52%)
- Arts & entertainment (53%)
