- Provided with the goal of reducing or eliminating claims under the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP)
- ➤ Authorized by Section 1366 of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended
- ➤ Homeowners must have flood insurance to qualify for the program
