Q: Will a Principal registered as a Professional Engineer in the discipline of Civil engineering satisfy this requirement? YES. Section 1.6 References All services and documents will meet the standard requirements as to format and content; and will be prepared in accordance with the latest applicable editions, supplements, and revisions to the following: 1. Civil Engineering 2. Electrical Engineering 3. Mechanical Engineering 4. Structural Engineering 5. Surveying Q: Please clarify what references are being requested in this requirement

DESIGN SUBMITTALS AND PROFESSIONAL SUBMITTALS MUST BE DONE BY A CERTIFIED ENGINEER IN THE DISCIPLINE REQUIRED.

On the first page of the advertisement, it states "Each submission must contain one original, and eight copies." However, on page eight of the RFQ, it states "...one signed original and five copies..." Please clarify the correct number of copies needed for submittal. Thank you.

ONE ORIGINAL AND FIVE COPIES WILL BE SUFFICIENT

To effectively plan and form a successful project team for this Retainer Contract it would be useful to know an anticipated (minimum and maximum) contract value. Will the Parish be willing/able to share an estimated contract value for SOQ preparations?

NOT AT THIS TIME.

Section 1.5 Qualifications/Contract Requirements 1. Please clarify requirement 1 of this section. Is this stated correctly or does only one Principal of the Prime Consultant have to be a registered P.E. in LA? 2. If the requirement in No.1 is that only one Principal of the Prime Consultant be registered P.E. in LA, can requirement 1 and 2 be satisfied by the same P.E.?

IT IS TRUE THAT ONLY ONE PRINCIPLE OF THE PRIME CONSULTANT HAS TO BE A REGISTERED P.E. IN LOUISIANA. HOWEVER, SUBMITTALS WHERE ENGINEERING SERVICES ARE REQUIRED MUST BE DONE BY AN ENGINEER MEETING THE REQUIREMENT OF THE ETHICS OF THAT DISCIPLINE.
