During the prebid meeting it was mentioned that each task order would have a 1-year duration.
Are the base bid and alternate 1 considered to be separate task orders with 1 year duration each?

The intent will be to have a set of roads to be done during a year, though the Parish may decide to break the work into multiple task orders with a shorter duration. This will depend on the price of the bids received. As mentioned during the meeting, Alternate 2 is not comprised of many roads, so it would be anticipated that a task order with just Alt 2 roads would have a duration of months, not 1 year.

 Will this project be awarded to the contractor with the combined lowest price for the base bid, alternate 1, and alternate 2? If not, how will Ascension determine which bidder is selected to perform this work?

The project will be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder. The selection of the lowest responsible and responsive bidder will be determined by Louisiana Revised Statue 38:2212(J), which states, in part, "Determination of the low bidder shall be on the basis of the sum of the base bid and any alternates accepted."
