## ASCENSION PARISH GOVERNMENT DECLARES LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

**ASCENSION PARISH, LA-** In response to the forecasted extended subfreezing temperatures and potential precipitation of rain, sleet, or snow, Ascension Parish Government, under the leadership of Parish President Clint Cointment, has declared a local state of emergency. This declaration grants the authority to take immediate measures to ensure the safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of Ascension Parish.

Due to the anticipated closure of roads and bridges, which poses a significant risk to the safety of employees, all non-essential parish offices and buildings will be closed on Tuesday, January 21, 2025. This decision has been made in accordance with the Ordinances of the Parish of Ascension, the Louisiana Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act of 1993, and other prevailing acts.

The primary objective of this declaration is to minimize the threat to property and the well-being of the citizens of Ascension Parish.

President Clint Cointment emphasizes the importance of prioritizing the safety of all residents during this challenging weather event. The local state of emergency will remain in effect until further notice.
